Pain relief for Ewes

The use of pain relief in ewes at certain times can have dramatic benefits. If a ewe has had a tough time lambing, she is bruised and sore, a single treatment of "Metacam" (Meloxicam) reduces pain and swelling, speeding up recovery and treatment success, and also increasing feed intake, milk production and therefore improves her lambs. Use of "Metacam" in ewes which are lame or suffering mastitis also has huge benefits and her lambs are more likely to thrive and grow well. The cost of treatment is approximately £1.50 per ewe.

BVD & Lepto Vaccination Reminder

Believe it or not, we are now entering the time to start thinking about and preparing for turnout! It is the time to boost your BVD and Lepto vaccinations. All cows should be boosted and don't forget to boost the bull as well.

All heifers over 8 months of age, which are likely to be put to the bull (or AI) in the next 12 months should receive a primary course of vaccination. This is two injections of each Leptavoid H and Bovilis BVD, 4 weeks apart. The primary course should be completed at least 4 weeks before going to the bull to ensure protection of the calf.
