Sheep Quarantine Treatments

Don't forget that incoming rams, ewes and lambs can bring with them worms, fluke and scab, which may or may not be carrying resistance. We recommend treating stock on arrival with Zolvix and an Ivermectin injectable (e.g. Cydectin) as well as treating for Liver Fluke. If you want to discuss options for quarantine treatments please contact the Office.

Enzovax and Toxovax

Reminder for those who usually use Enzovax and Toxovax, both vaccines are currently in good supply, please contact the Office to order.

Enzovax and Toxovax can be administered at the same time but not mixed together. Ewes should be vaccinated at least 4 weeks before the rams go in.

Immunity provided against Enzootic Abortion and Toxoplasmosis is considered to be lifetime, no boosters are required in sheep.

Toxovax has a very short shelf life and is only delivered by special order. When ordering Toxovax you must specify when you would like to use the vaccine.
