#### Rabbits with Myxomatosis

We continue to see cases of Myxomatosis in pet rabbits. This disease is usually fatal and devastating. Your rabbit can be protected from this disease by vaccination. Please ring the Office for more information.

### Bovine Tuberculosis Update

Testing is continuing this summer with the situation remaining serious. Short Interval Testing or Breakdown testing can be done by either us or Animal Health. If you have an outstanding TB test, especially Short Interval Test, contact the Office to arrange a date. If you do contact Animal Health they are likely to arrange the test with their Vets (or Animal Health Officers) rather than asking us to do it.

### Enzovax & Toxovax

Remember it is now time to order your supplies of Enzovax & Toxovax. Both should be given to ewe lambs at least 4 weeks before they go to the ram.
